Slides to include pictures of the North Country, a map of the area showing where we are located close to Ottawa, Plattsburgh, Syracuse and local airports. Have Randy talk about all the four colleges within a 20 mile radius of each other (reference we may have a few thousand students, but there are several thousands students in the area that you can interact with/Small college campus, but large college community) and emphasize on our diverse community (rural neighborhood, Amish community, and we have a lot of city students that come up and we have a unique blend that gives it it's own charm).
